

SEEKING ACTORS FOR CAPTAIN HOOK AND PETER PAN

Broadway Bootcamp is excited to announce open auditions for our Summer Touring Company show, an interactive musical theatre performance touring to the Muskegon Area District Libraries. We are looking for two talented actors to fill the roles of Captain Hook and Peter Pan.

- Actors must be comfortable with interactive performance, teaching singing and dancing, and audience engagement.
- Actors must have transportation to and from the designated carpool meetup spot.
- Actors must have availability for all performance dates and times, with no exceptions.
- Actors must be available for rehearsals prior to the event (minimum two 1-hour rehearsals the week before performances)

Show Details:

Join us for an interactive musical theatre adventure that will captivate audiences of all ages at the Muskegon Area District Libraries. In this 45-minute show, Peter Pan embarks on a mission to the library with the goal of getting Captain Hook hooked on reading! Though Hook is initially reluctant and has never explored the wonders of the library, Peter Pan—with the enthusiastic help of the audience—shows him the magic of books. Throughout the performance, audiences will be treated to popular musical theatre melodies, encouraging everyone to sing and dance along. This dynamic and engaging show promises to make reading an exciting and fun adventure for the whole family.

Character Descriptions:

Both roles are open to actors of any gender.

Captain Hook:

- Description: Charismatic and cunning pirate captain with a flair for the dramatic. Hook is theatrical, larger-than-life, and has a commanding presence that can captivate an audience.
- Requirements: Strong acting skills are essential for this role, as Hook is both a villain and a humorous character. The ability to project authority and command the stage is crucial. While some singing is required, this role involves less singing than Peter Pan. Physicality is important, as Hook often engages in animated and exaggerated movements. This role will also teach choreography/movement.

Peter Pan:

- Description: Peter Pan is a playful and adventurous boy who never wants to grow up. He is full of youthful energy and charm, with a mischievous and spirited personality.
- Requirements: This role requires physical agility and youthful energy to convincingly portray Peter's boundless enthusiasm and adventurous spirit. Strong acting skills are necessary to embody Peter's whimsical and carefree nature. Peter Pan must be a strong singer with a wide vocal range to handle the musical demands of the role.

Performance Dates:

- July 15 - 17: Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday
- Times: 9:30 am - 4:00 pm
- Locations: Performances will take place at 9 libraries in the Muskegon area: Montague, Holton, Dalton, Ravenna, Egelston, Muskegon Township, Muskegon Heights, North Muskegon, & Norton Shores. The director and performers will travel to 3 locations per day.

Rehearsals:

Location: Downtown Muskegon (physical address shared upon casting)

Schedule: Rehearsals will be scheduled to fit performers' schedules; minimum of two 1-hour rehearsals with both performers required the week prior to the performances.

How to Apply:

- To set up an in-person audition slot: Email broadwaybootcampusa@gmail.com with your preferred time to audition on Friday, May 24th from 9am-12pm.
- To submit a video audition: Record a slate (name & part(s) interested in, and why you think you would be a good fit for the Tour Company), a monologue (select either Captain Hook or Peter Pan's), and sing an audition cut (16-32 bars/<1 min). Ensure good lighting, sound quality, and a distraction-free background. Keep the entire video under 7 minutes.

Audition Tape Submissions:

- Deadline: 12:00 pm on 5/24
- Requirements: Please keep submissions under 7 minutes. Ensure good lighting, sound quality, and a distraction-free background.
- Content: Slate (Name & part(s) interested in, and why you think you would be a good fit for the Tour Company), monologue (select either Captain Hook or Peter Pan's), and sing audition cut (16-32 bars/<1 min).

Audition Preparation:

- Headshot and Resume: Optional.
- Song: Prepare a song (16-32 bars) that showcases your range and suitability for either role. Provide an instrumental/karaoke track for accompaniment.
- Monologue: Select one provided monologue to perform. (Monologues attached) Memorization is not required at the time of audition, but please make sure you're comfortable with the text.
